The college, formally founded some sixty years back in the concourse of the Vijay Laxmi Cinema Hall of the local market area on 7th of July in the year 1966, has travelled a long distance and, has traversed many Mile-Stones experiencing dimensional and phenomenal growth over years from Vyasadeva College of Arts, Science & technology in its inception to Vyasasanagar Autonomous College at present.. The college in the academic year remained eventful:-

- ❖ The **College was re-opened** after the Summer Vacation of the year on 16th June, 2025. The faculties & Staff-members were allocated different Co-Curricular & Extra-Curricular assignments in an office notification.

Admissions to the +2, +3 & PG First Year classes were conducted under the Students' Academic Management System in consonance with the notifications of the Government from time to time. A total number of 577, 581 & 33 students were finally admitted to the +2, +3 & PG First Year Classes of the college respectively at the close of the admission process.

The classes were started as per the Government prescribed schedule followed by Induction Programmes separately.

The Higher **Secondary Classes** of the college composite system were shifted to the new academic infrastructure in the beginning of the academic session.

The **Board of Studies and the Academic Council Meetings** of the college autonomous system were duly completed on the NEP-20 Syllabus on 10th September & 24th September of the year respectively.

- ❖ In the year, 11 numbers of faculties and employees in the college establishment have **retired** from their services attaining the age of superannuation and, another 05 will retire by the end of the academic year. Farewell functions in respect of the retirees were enthusiastically organised to bid them a heart-felt farewell.
- ❖ To the pride of the college, two faculties were transferred to other colleges as Principal In-Charge there.
- ❖ The college was shocked at the sad demise of an honest and innocent working lady *Safei Saathi* **Mrs. Dolly Mukhi** after a prolonged treatment.
- ❖ Experiencing substantial vacancies in the position of teaching faculties and support staff due to Transfer, Superannuation and premature Death cases, 04 numbers of faculties in the Department of Odia, 01 in Hindi, 02 numbers of Demonstrators one each in the Department of Chemistry and Zoology, and 02 numbers of Sweepers (*Safei Saathi*) in the college establishment were contractually engaged in a **Walk-in-Interview** duly conducted on 20th

July of the year to cater to the academic needs of the students and to maintain cleanliness in the college infrastructure.

- ❖ The Hon'ble MLA, Korei Sj. Akash Das Nayak and, the President, Governing Body of the college & ADM, Kalinganagar Sj. Sapan Kumar Nanda fruitfully **shared with faculties and employees** of the college in the Conference Hall on date 26.06.2025 to boost the Staff morale.
